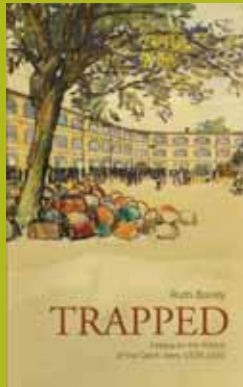


New on the Shelf...

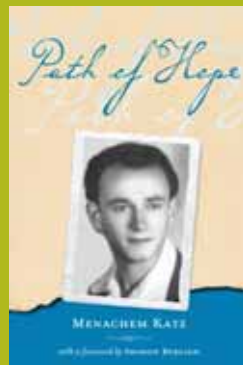
Ruth Bondy, *Trapped*, 240 pp.; NIS 129

■ This unique work addresses special aspects of Theresienstadt and the history of Czech Jewry. Bondy includes descriptions of the use of humor in coping with everyday life in Terezin; the status of privileged individuals; the fate of women; a young man's relief project; and the Auschwitz family camp through the eyes of the children imprisoned there. *Trapped* portrays a kaleidoscope of people caught in terrible adversity, but who nevertheless managed, for the most part, to retain their humanity.



Menachem Katz, *Path of Hope*, 209 pp.; NIS 69

■ This gripping memoir opens with the spectacular escape of eighteen-year-old Munio (Menachem) Katz from the liquidation of the last Jews of Brzezany on 12 June 1943. He was the only one of his group of forced laborers to get away. He and seven others were hidden for the following year by the Kmiec family, until they were finally liberated.
