Money was not a problem. Food, by then, was somewhat of a problem. I think food was actually limited to certain items and I do remember, with gratitude here, a Ukrainian peasant who used to be a client of my grandfather's, who would come every week from the country and bring us eggs and butter, for no money or anything, just as such. So that's something that I do remember and have always remembered. I've never traced this man, I don't know what he was like, I just know that there was such a person.
