Subject: Evacuation of 1,000 Jews from France

Reference: Discussion of 6 March 1942

It is intended to deport to the concentration camp Auschwitz (Upper Silesia), 1,000 Jews who were arrested in Paris on 12 December 1941 on the occasion of the reprisal measures for the attempts on members of the German Wehrmacht.

Involved are only Jews of French nationality or stateless Jews.

It is planned to move these 1,000 Jews, who are at present assembled in a camp at Compiègne, by special train on 23 March 1942.
